Through group work, they will enhance their teamwork and collaboration abilities, learn effective interviewing techniques, and strengthen their presentation skills. Additionally, students will engage with their community and reflect on their learning journey, promoting personal growth and a deeper connection to their local heritage.

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## **Expected Results**

The project will result in students developing a wide range of valuable skills, including research, active listening, interviewing, digital literacy, teamwork, and presentation skills. Tangible outputs include a joint e-book documenting students' findings, a Wakelet digital exhibition showcasing local and school history, collaboratively designed logos and posters, and interactive activities like a final Kahoot quiz. Students will enhance their understanding of local history, build stronger connections to their communities, and increase their digital competence through the use of Web 2.0 tools. The project will also foster collaboration among partner schools, with students working together in teams across schools and sharing their insights through Twinspace, Padlet, and other platforms. Dissemination activities, such as field trips, reflective discussions, and social media sharing, will ensure that the project's impact extends to the wider school community and beyond.
